



ROSLYN SCHOOL SPRING 2022 ACTIVITIES PROGRAM

(Limited 8-week program)

We would like to introduce the Roslyn School Activities Program selections for the Spring session of the 2022 school year scheduled to start the week of March 14th, 2022.

SPRING: Registration will be available online and is scheduled to open on **Tuesday February 15th starting at 7 a.m. for K students ONLY.** Registration for grades 1-6 will open on **Wednesday February 16th** *ALL registration will close on Wednesday February 23rd at 7 p.m.*

You are invited to visit roslynhands.ca and click on “Extra-Curricular Activities” to preview the program offerings.

NOTE: Your registration session is limited to 30 minutes. Confirming you can log into your account at <https://roslynhands.ca/my-account/> ahead of time will allow you to shop for activities without any added stress or delays.

If you do not have an account, you do not have to do anything yet - your account will be created at checkout, you will just have to enter your details, rather than them being prefilled from your account settings. If you are unable to log into your existing account and cannot reset your password, please email webmaster@roslynhands.ca to resolve BEFORE registration opens to avoid delays.

ALL activities have limited spaces and the inventory shown is live once registration begins. If an activity is unavailable, you may place your child on a waitlist. If or when a space becomes available, you will be notified via email and invited to join the class. We urge you to review your purchases before checking out. You will be issued a receipt at this time which should be printed and kept for your income tax records. No other receipt will be issued.

CODE OF CONDUCT: The instructors are there to teach their specialty, as such, we ask that you review the following with your child/children.

The program operates under the “3 strikes and you’re out” rule.

- 1st strike, a written note will be sent home with your child explaining the situation.
- 2nd strike, your child will be suspended from the activity the following week.
- 3rd strike, your child will be removed from the activity permanently and without refund.

NOTE: Children are required to wear a mask while participating in their activity. The only exception will be during lunch where they will be allowed to remove their mask for a maximum of 15 mins.

We ask that you please refrain from ordering your child a hot lunch on a day where they have a scheduled activity. Consider sending them with a quick and easy lunch. This will help to minimize the time of exposure and allow more time for the activity.

All participants enrolled in the activities program are required to respect the instructor, each other, as well as the environment in which the course is held.



After school Supervision Program:

We are pleased to announce the return of the “After school supervision program” **offered ONLY to children enrolled in the after-school SPORTS activities on the day(s) for which they are registered.**

This applies to Soccer, Cosom Hockey, Martials Arts, and Basketball ONLY.

This will allow you to pick your child up until 6:00 p.m. regardless of the time their activity class finishes. We do however **STRONGLY** encourage you to collect your child, whenever possible, at the time when their activity finishes to help limit contact.

NOTE: Should you be unable to pick up your child at the required time for all other after school activities (Glee, Gardening, Piano, Etc.) please **DO NOT** register your child in those activities. Should you do so and are unable to pick up your child at the appropriate finish time of the activity, your child will be removed from the activity without refund.

We require that **ALL** children be picked up at **6:00**. This is the latest possible pick-up time for all activities.

Late fees of \$5 per 5 minutes will be applied after 6 p.m. and your child/children will not be allowed to return to the activities program until these fees are paid in full. Three (3) late pickups and your child will be permanently removed from ALL after-school activities without refund.

A timely pick up is essential for us to limit congestion and facilitate a smooth and fluid dismissal. After school dismissal and pick up will be conducted at the front entrance of the school ONLY. You are not permitted to enter the school to retrieve forgotten homework or for any other reason.

We are immensely proud of the diverse offerings of the Activities Program and hope that you will be able to find something which will engage your child and enrich their Roslyn school experience.
